

## THORNHILL PAPERS

Records of the Thornhill family of Great Longstone. The Thornhills, once a farming family, played an extensive role in parish life throughout the 19<sup>th</sup> Century. Most of the parish records found in this collection relate to Robert Thornhill, Overseer of the Poor, clerk to the Commissioners of Taxes and the last High Constable for High Peak Hundred.

In addition to parish records, the Thornhill Papers also include family papers from the 19<sup>th</sup> century onwards, Turnpike records and papers relating to DP Battery Co Ltd, 1894 to 1970, and to the *Wharfedale family*

The following documents were deposited in the Record Office from December 1964 to December 1973.
