

Ault Hucknall Apprentices

1741 - 1796

Introduction

This typescript brings together the pertinent Apprenticeship information from the surviving apprenticeship documents for the parish of Ault Hucknall, which are deposited in the Derbyshire Record Office. They comprise:

D1476 A/PO 187 - 202 Apprenticeship Indentures 1741 - 1796
D1476 A/PO 203 Agreement to take an apprentice 1755

Except for the apprenticeship of 1757, all the apprenticeships concern parish apprentices, ie the parish via the Overseers of the Poor, arranged and if necessary paid for the relevant child's apprenticeship. This usually meant that the child or its family were receiving parish relief and thus qualified for the parish to be responsible for the apprenticing of the child.

Except for the 1755 document, all of the documents are pre-printed forms to which the relevant personal details were added in hand, which accounts for the variation in information given. Unfortunately the Overseers of the Poor did not include the parentage of the apprentice on the indentures but from 1795 did include the apprentice's age.

The documents themselves have been microfilmed (Ref: XM 43¹/48 Item 4) and are available in that form at the Derbyshire Record Office.

At the back of this typescript there are surname and location indices.

Ault Hucknall Apprentices 1741 - 1796

1741

Elizabeth Redfern is apprenticed to John Clay of Astwith in the parish of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 23rd June 1741.

Thomas Gaskin is apprenticed to Richard Marriott of Rowthorne in the parish of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 23rd June 1741.

Mary Redfern is apprenticed to Richard Sanders of Stainsby in the parish of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 23rd June 1741.

1742

Obadiah Redfern is apprenticed to Roger Hollinworth to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 21st April 1742.

1744

Ann Newton is apprenticed to John Fisher of Rowthorne in the parish of Ault Hucknall until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 28th March 1744.

D1476 A/PO 193

Sarah Ashford is apprenticed to John Brocksopp to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 21st June 1744.

Anne Ashford is apprenticed to Jonathan Brafitt to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 21st June 1744.

D1476 A/PO 192

1747

Joseph Bower is apprenticed to Samuel Brealsford of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 2nd July 1747.

D1476 A/PO 194

1752

Mary Ashford is apprenticed to Francis Clay of Ault Hucknall, farmer, to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 4th April 1752.

John Ashford is apprenticed to Richard Jepson of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 18th May 1752.

1755

At a vestry meeting called on the 9th November 1755, it was unanimously agreed by the parishoners present on the one part and John Clay of Hardstoft in the parish of Ault Hucknall on the other part, that the said John Clay is to take & keep and dispose of Ishmael Clay of Hardstoft in every respect as a parish apprentice, though not bound. If the apprentice is returned before he attains the age of 24, he would be treated as a parish apprentice and bound as such to somebody else. Memorandum dated 19th November 1755.

1756

Sarah North is apprenticed to John Brailsford of Ault Hucknall, gentleman, to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 12th April 1756.

1757

George Street, son of George Street of Hardstoft in the parish of Ault Hucknall, tailor, deceased, is apprenticed to Samuel Culley of Nottingham in the county of Nottinghamshire, framework knitter, for 7 years. Indenture dated 25th April 1757.

John North is apprenticed to William Derry of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 2nd May 1757.

1759

James Searston is apprenticed to John Hardwick of Ault Hucknall, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 8th February 1759.

1795

Hannah Berrey, aged 9, is apprenticed to Benjamin Marriott of Ault Hucknall, farmer, to learn the art of housewifery until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 7th May 1795.

1796

Richard Lee, aged 7, is apprenticed to Samuel Marriott of Ault Hucknall, farmer, to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 7th January 1796.
