# Bolsover Parish Apprentices

1784 - 1814

#### Introduction

This typescript brings together the pertinent Apprenticeship information from the surviving apprenticeship documents for the parish of Bolsover, which are deposited in the Derbyshire Record Office. They comprise:

D190 A/PO 196-204 Apprenticeship Indenturea 1784 - 1814

The apprentices were, in most cases, classed as paupers and thus qualified to have the cost of their apprenticeship paid for by the parish. However, this does mean that their indentures were exempt from the tax levied upon them during the period 1710 - 1808, so they should not appear in the relevant Inland Revenue volumes at the Public Record Office for between these two dates.

The indentures are in all cases are pre-printed forms with the relevant details added by hand, but this unfortunately meant that there was no room for details of the apprentices parentage. In all cases the master also came from Bolsover; whether this is a coincidence or a deliberate policy of the parish Overseers of the Poor is not known.

The records themselves have been microfilmed (Ref: XM 1/47 item 4) and are available in that form at the Derbyshire Record Office.

# Bolsover Parish Apprentices 1784 - 1814

#### 1784

Thomas Pogmore of Bolsover is apprenticed to Samuel Jackson of Bolsover, farmer, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 29th June 1784.

#### 1788

Thomas Middleton of Bolsover is apprenticed to Abraham Scott of Bolsover, farmer, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 9th May 1788.

D190 A/PO 197

#### 1789

George Glossop of Bolsover is apprenticed to John Barker of Bolsover, husbandman, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 7th January 1789.

D190 A/PO 198

Sarah Pogmore of Bolsover is apprenticed to Matthew Jackson of Bolsover, butcher, to learn the art of housewifery, until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 10th January 1789.

## 1791

Rebecca Rhodes of Bolsover is apprenticed to Richard Flint of Bolsover, surgeon, to learn the art of housewifery, until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 14th March 1791.

#### 1798

Sarah Marsh, aged 8, of Bolsover, is apprenticed to William Marsh of Bolsover, wheelwright, to learn the art of housewifery, until she attains the of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 7th December 1798.

## 1801

James Garner, aged 7, of Bolsover, is apprenticed to John Johnson of Bolsover, farmer, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 20th May 1801.

1808

Elizabeth Woodhead, aged 7, of Bolsover, is apprenticed to John Hinde of Bolsover, publican & farmer, until she attains the age of 21 or marries.

1814

Sarah Higginbotham, aged 9, of Bolsover, is apprenticed to Robert Lawrence of Bolsover, farmer, to learn the art of housewifery, until she attains the age of 21 or marries. Indenture dated 27th May 1814.
