Church Broughton Apprentices

1715 - 1820

Introduction

This typescript brings together the pertinent Apprenticeship information from the surviving apprenticeship documents for the parish of Church Broughton, which are deposited in the Derbyshire Record Office. They comprise:

The documents D854 A/PO 120 - 129 have been microfilmed and are available in that form (Ref: XM 1/36 Item 4).

In most cases the apprentices were poor or pauper children who qualified because of their circumstances to have their apprenticeships arranged and paid for by the Overseers of the Poor of the parish. This even applied in cases of qualified children who had moved from the parish, as it was the parish of settlement of the pauper child that was responsible for their apprenticing.

The information given in the documents varies considerably, as though most of the indentures are pre-printed forms, their format varies in the information that had to be added by hand.

At the back of this typescript ther are both surname and location indices.

1715

Thomas Morecroft, aged 11, is apprenticed to Edward Prattle of Church Broughton, yeoman, until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 8th August 1715.

1716

John Harrison, son of Samuel Harrison of Church Broughton, husbandman, is apprenticed to John Smedley of Burton upon Trent in the county of Staffordshire, tailor, for 7 years, commencing 24th June 1716. Premium £4. Indenture dated 21st June 1716.

1727

Robert Siddall, son of George Siddall of Church Broughton, is apprenticed to Caleb Vernon Smith of Uttoxeter in the county of Staffordshire, cordwainer, for 7 years. Premium £6. Indenture dated 4th February 1726/7.

1767

William Harrison, aged 13 on 30th September 1766, is apprenticed to Slater Shepherd of Church Broughton to learn the art of husbandry until he attains the age of 24. Indenture dated 4th May 1767.

1793

Joseph Dilks, aged 14, is apprenticed to Richard Barker of the parish of St Mary's in Nottingham in the county of Nottinghamshire, framework knitter, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 6th April 1793.

1801

William Upton, aged 9, is apprenticed to Robert Potter of Church Broughton, whittawer, to learn the arts of whittawer, saddler & whipmaker until he attains the age of 21. Premium £7 7s. Indenture dated 21st May 1801.

1811

Lewis Jackson, aged 12, son of William & Elizabeth Jackson of Church Broughton, is apprenticed to John Eason of Tutbury in the county of Staffordshire, cordwainer, until he attains the age of 21. Indenture dated 5th July 1811.

John Shaw, aged 11, son of Mary Shaw of Burton upon Trent in the county of Staffordshire, is apprenticed to Joseph Leedham of Burton upon Trent, cordwainer, until he attains the age of 21. Premium £10. Indenture dated 28th May 1812.

1814

Charles Jackson, aged 11, son of William & Elizabeth (deceased) Jackson of Church Broughton, is apprenticed to William Barrett of St Werburgh's parish in Derby, framework knitter, until he attains the age of 21. Premium £10. Indenture dated 14th January 1814.

Joseph Bentley, aged 9, son of Thomas Bentley, soldier, & Elizabeth Bentley, his wife, of Church Broughton, is apprenticed to William Barrett of St Werburgh's parish in Derby, framework knitter, until he attains the age of 21. Premium £10. Indenture dated 14th January 1814.

1820

Thomas Shaw, aged 14, the son of Mary Wheeldon, widow of the late Edward Shaw, is apprenticed to Thomas Bill of St Mary's parish in Stafford in the county of Staffordshire, cordwainer, until he attains the age of 21. Premium £10. Indenture dated 15th May 1820.
