

D1763 – Palmer-Morewood collection

This is an interim list of material in an archive collection which has been transferred to Derbyshire Record Office. No full comparison has ever been made between the descriptions given in this list and the actual contents of the archive held at this repository. It cannot be regarded as accurate or definitive; indeed, when the collection is finally catalogued, the list will be subject to considerable change.

The issuing of a copy of this list does not affect the status of collection D1763 as an unlisted collection. Any researcher wishing to make use of the material should start by contacting Derbyshire Record Office to discuss their requirements and negotiate access. The record office reserves the right to refuse to produce documents from the collection until it has been catalogued

This collection consists of

- (1) 21 boxes of documents relating to Warwickshire, unlisted.
- (2) 21 boxes of numbered bundles. The bundles have been divided into 9 groups numbered from 1/ to 9/. Each bundle has been given a sub-number after the stroke, eg. 1/ contains 28 bundles numbered 1/1, 1/2, 1/3 and so on to 1/28.

These bundles have been listed by the National Register of Archives using this numbering for reference purposes (although the bundles have not been listed in numerical sequence).

The numbers by which these bundles may be identified and by which they should be ordered are in the column headed "Serial No" in the National Register of Archives List. Thus, when ordering the first item on page 1 of the NRA list, the reference to quote is D1763 M/4/1. Note that the 5-figure numbers written in the 'Date' column of the NRA list are not to be used.
