These almanacs have no obvious connection with the Wilmot Horton family. Internal evidence suggests strongly that the some of the later almanacs from about 1750 onwards belonged to Cornelius Brough and subsequent members of this family - the almanac for 1827 is marked 'C Brough'. However, nearly all these later examples are blank, so there is little opportunity to discover anything more about these people.

On the other hand, the seventeenth and early eighteenth century examples quite clearly belonged to successive members of the Palmer family. John Palmer (see, for example, WH 3486) was archdeacon of Northampton, 1665-1679 (death), and married Bridget, daughter of Clifton Catesby of Ecton. He was rector of Ecton (Northants), 1641-1679, and his sons John (1656-1688) and Thomas (1660- 1715) were successively rectors there, 1680-1688 (death) and 1689-1715 (death). The younger John went up to Trinity College Cambridge in April 1673 - almanacs belonging to him clearly survive, for example WH 3512. The father of the elder John Palmer (1612-1679) was Joseph Palmer, gent, of Cropredy (Oxon): some of the earlier almanacs here refer to events in Oxfordshire. The Palmers and the Whalleys, related by marriage, were successively incumbents of Ecton from 1641 to at least 1830.
