#### Introduction

This typescript brings together the pertinent Apprenticeship information from the surviving apprenticeship documents for the parish of Eckington, which are deposited in the Derbyshire Record Office. They comprise:

D750 A/PO 82 - 199 Apprenticeship Indentures 1674 - 1814

Except for the two indentures concerning Samuel S(e/i)lvester, all of the apprentices came from the parish of Eckington. In most cases because the apprentice was classed as a pauper, the apprenticeship was arranged and paid for by the Overseers of the Poor for Eckington.

The indentures are in most cases, pre-printed forms with the relevant details added by hand. Unfortunately, this means that in virtually all cases the father of the apprentice is not given, and in some cases the abode or occupation of the master is not given either. However it is likely in these cases that the master would be resident in the parish of Eckington, and as there was a tendency to apprentice boys to learn the art of husbandry and girls the art of housewifery, it is probable that this applied in these cases.
