

# Winster Apprentices 1715 - 1828

## Introduction

This typescript brings together the pertinent Apprenticeship information from the surviving apprenticeship documents for the parish of Winster, which are deposited in the Derbyshire Record Office. They comprise:

The apprentices were in virtually all cases classed as poor or paupers and thus qualified to have the cost of their apprenticeships paid for by the parish. Most of the indentures are on pre-printed forms to which the relevant details were added by hand, which leads to considerable variation in the information given. Except for three indentures all of the apprentices came from Winster. The three indentures for non-Winster apprentices may possibly be accounted for by being for individuals who originally had a settlement at Winster and had moved elsewhere; it was still the responsibility of the Overseers of Winster to carry out their apprenticing if they were reduced to pauper status.
